A GUIDE TO FOOD WASTE COLLECTION



WHAT CAN I PUT IN MY GREEN BIN?

Anything from nature can go in your food waste bin:

- Food scraps
- Meat, skin and bones
- Fish and sea shells
- Flowers
- Coffee grounds and tea bags
- Hair, animal fur
- Kitchen paper towels (not wet wipes)
- Dirty, and oil stained paper
- Cardboard e.g. pizza boxes, egg cartons

When your green compostable liner is full put it in your green kerbside collection bin. You can also put food scraps directly into your green kerbside bin without it being in a compostable liner bag. Place your green bin out for collection when it's full.

Your green bin should be at the kerbside by 8:00AM on collection day. If you cannot put your kerbside collection out on your collection day please take it to the transfer station.

On public holidays all kerbside collection will be as per your normal day expect for Christmas Day and New Years Day. They will be collected the following day.

There are two trucks, one for green bins and one for blue bins and pink bags. The trucks come at different times, which may be some hours apart.

Put your green bin out on the same day* as your pink bag and blue bin. *except for Waiouru see back of brochure

Audits of pink rubbish bags show that on average over half of most bags are filled with food and other compostable material. Taking this out of the landfill waste stream will save ratepayers a lot of money while helping to protect our environment.
