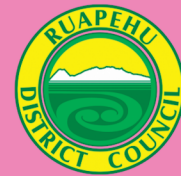

A GUIDE TO KERBSIDE COLLECTION

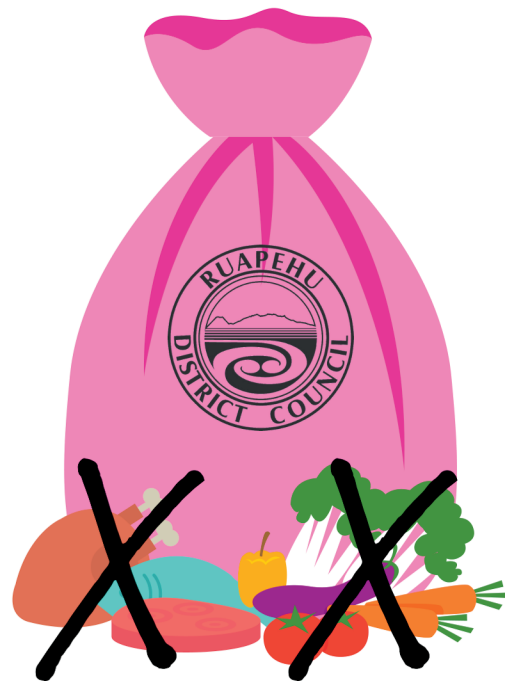


RUAPEHU DISTRICT COUNCIL OFFICIAL REFUSE BAG

- All things should be wrapped
- No hot ashes
- No bricks
- No garden refuse
- No corrosive or inflammable liquids
- No dangerous substances
- Maximum weight 10kg
- Maximum height 1.1m
- Maximum length 1.1m
- Maximum width 0.6m

Did you know that half of most kerbside rubbish bags could be composted! Please make sure to use your green bins.

Did you know that you can take your used household batteries, cellphone and laptop batteries to any council offices to be disposed of responsibly on your behalf. All other batteries can be taken to our transfer stations.



Refuse for collection must be in an official pink council bag. We can collect 2-3 bags per household, if you have more bags taken then to your local transfer station.

All broken glass should be wrapped in newspaper and put into your pink bag.

Your pink bag should be at the kerbside by 8:00AM on collection day. If you have more bags take them to your local transfer station.

On public holidays all kerbside collection will be as per your normal day expect for Christmas Day and New Years Day. They will be collected the following day.

There are two trucks, one for green bins and one for blue bins and pink bags. The trucks come at different times, which may be some hours apart.

Put your pink bag out on the same day* as your green bin and blue bin. **except for Waiouru see back of brochure*

Official rubbish bags can be purchased from all council offices and local shops. Bags come in 60L and 35L* options.

****35L is only available at our council offices***
