RESERVED DECISION OF THE RUAPEHU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Kelly Phillips made the application on the prescribed form received on the 4 July 2024. The applicant is currently employed as a van driver and bar person at Taumarunui and District Returned Services Association, a role she has held for 15 months.

The application included the applicant's qualifications and evidence attesting to the applicant's suitability to hold a certificate.

The applicant has attained the relevant License Controller Qualification and has not incurred any convictions.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- (c) any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:
- (d) any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under section 218:
- (e) any matters dealt with in any report made under section 220.

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and considered during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition within report dated 15 July 2024.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing **Kelly Phillips** credentials against the Acts criteria. The inspector has interviewed the applicant and is satisfied that the applicant has the necessary knowledge to hold the certificate.

The inspector concludes that there is no opposition to the application. I support this conclusion.

4 Conclusion

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Kelly Phillips** meets the criteria to be granted a Managers Certificate in accordance with the Act.

5 Decision

Accordingly, the application for manager's certificate is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year.
