DECISION OF THE RUAPEHU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Angus Jordan Falvey made the application on the prescribed form received on the 25 June 2024. The applicant intends using the certificate at 'Powderhorn Chateau/Turoa Lodge'. The applicant has been employed in the industry for a number of years now.

The application included evidence of obtaining the necessary License Controller Qualification and attesting to their experience and skills. The applicant declared they have no convictions.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- (c) any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:
- (d) any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under <u>section 218</u>:
- (e) any matters dealt with in any report made under section 220.

3. Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition within report dated 26 June 2024.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing Angus Falvey's credentials against the Acts criteria, including an assessment interview.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete, in all aspects appear to meet the criteria of section 222 of the Act to hold a managers certificate.

4. Conclusion

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that Angus Falvey meets the criteria to hold a Managers Certificate under the Act.

5. Decision

Accordingly the application is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year.
